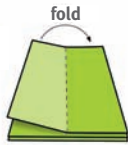

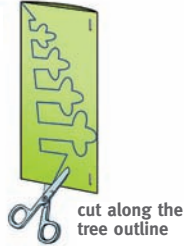

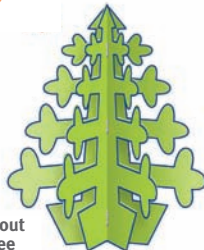

Activity 2: Make a paper tree

While the sermon is happening, here is a quiet activity for the young children in the service.

You will need:

3 sheets A4 paper, preferably coloured green, for each child.
Pens or pencils for drawing a line, scissors, stapler, gummed shapes or colouring pencils

Here's what you do:

- Step 1** Fold the 3 sheets of paper in half lengthways.
- Step 2** Staple the two open corners of the folded paper.
- Step 3** Opposite the fold, draw branches and leaves in outline in one single line.
- Step 4** Using the outline you have drawn as a guide, cut along it.
- Step 5** You can now open out your tree. Staple down the centre fold.
- Step 6** Decorate by drawing on fruits or nuts and colouring in or by sticking gummed shapes onto your tree.
